Asking for someone's opinion:

What do you think? What's your opinion? What do you think of...? Don't you find/think that...? Are you of the opinion that...? Are you really for that? ..., isn't that so?

Stating your own opinion: You know...

I think/believe/find... Well, I'm of the opinion that... I'm convinced, that... In my opinion...

Responding neutrally:

Well, yes, but... Yes, I see what you mean. Whatever you think. We'll see. I don't care.

Agreeing in part:

That's true, but... Yes, but... That may be so, but... Maybe you're right, but on the other hand Yes, possibly. I'm not sure about that. For sure, on the other hand... Sometimes yes, sometimes no.

Disagreeing strongly:

That's simply not true. That doesn't make any sense. You've got to be kidding. That's crazy. But look, ... No way! Complete garbage! But that's nonsense.

On the contrary.

It's wrong (incorrect) that...
I'm of the other opinion...

For many reasons...

For the following reasons: first...second...
